



South Harbor Indoor Worship Service Information

We will be worshipping indoors at 8am, 9am & 11am

- One of our awesome volunteers will open the doors for you when you arrive for a touchless entry.
- At our 8am service, masks will be worn while in the building for the entirety of the service. This service will be held in the Café area and will not include singing.
- At our 9am & 11am services, masks will be worn while in the building. Masks may be removed while we are seated during the sermon.
- When you enter the Worship Center, every other row will be roped off to provide adequate distance between families. We ask that you leave at least 2 seats between your family and others in your row.
- We are able to gather outside of the building for fellowship before and after the services.
- We will not be able to provide coffee or water for now, so please feel free to bring a beverage with you. Please also dispose of any trash before you leave.
- If you or a family member have been exposed to or have COVID-19 symptoms, or if you prefer to watch online, we invite you to join us for our 11am service live stream on our [Facebook page](#) and [Vimeo channel](#). We'll be praying for you and can't wait to see you when you're ready!

- Offering baskets will not be passed as we do our best to be as "contactless" as possible, so giving online or in one of the new offering boxes located in the Worship Center is encouraged!
