Medication Form

Medications must come in original bottles with name of medication, dosage and students name clearly labeled. There will be no exceptions! Students will not be allowed to keep any medication on their person. (This includes any and all over the counter medications including Tylenol and Motrin). With the increased number of students and the open area of where all students will be sleeping this is a safety and security risk if students keep meds. Know that the camp nurse will have Motrin, Tylenol, antacids and other miscellaneous medications available. If a student needs a medication while on the worksite -- they can come see the nurse at breakfast time and get a one time dose to go with them. This new rule will be strictly enforced and for the safety of fellow students is **NON NEGOTIABLE**.
